9:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m.— Using Aeration in Your Water & Wastewater System - Daniel Johnson; Triplepoint (Dual Credit) We will discuss nitrification, denitrification, and Phosphorus removal in aerated lagoons including process modifications or using hybrid mechanical technologies to supplement existing lagoons. to aerate drinking water intakes to reduce algae, taste, and odor problems, and storm water ponds to reduce algae and odor.

10:30 a.m.-11:15 a.m.— Stakeholder and Public Communications for Infrastructure Projects - Sophia Parr and Michael Goldrich; Chastain Engineers (Dual Credit) This presentation will cover techniques for identifying stakeholders, strategies for effective outreach, and tools for targeted communications.

11:15 a.m.-12:00 p.m.— Practical Uses of AI in Water and Wastewater Utilities - Ken Hayes; Core and Main (Dual Credit) Discussion will provide real examples and provide a basis for understanding this emerging technology.

1:00 p.m.-1:45 p.m.— Proper Lab Procedures - Kelly Klostermann; Teklab, Inc. (Dual Credit) A requested topic from last year's feedback. Find out at this session if your sampling technique is correct. Both water and wastewater sampling will be discussed.

1:45 p.m.-2:30 p.m.— Telemetry & SCADA 101 - How to Alarm, Monitor, and Control with Today's Tech - Sam Cole; Gasvoda & Associates (Dual Credit) This presentation will cover types of telemetry and SCADA equipment, communication methods, and what you might monitor. It will help the modern operator see how they can be better informed, manage more with less time, all without breaking the bank and maybe even using some of your existing equipment.
