Position to be filled:

Operator/Class A - The operators are responsible for creating potable water from the Kaskaskia River and maintaining the integrity of the distribution system.

General Statement of Duties:

This position requires technical ability. Collect and analyze water samples, process control, chemical adjustments, daily & monthly reporting, routine maintenance, rotating shift (days/evenings/weekends).

Essential Job Functions:

- Check chemical levels and refill or replace containers.
- Check water levels and pump operations.
- Maintains chemical feed pumps to ensure proper dosage of chemicals.
- Backwash filters as required.
- Must be capable of using push mower and zero turn mower to maintain facility grounds.
- Will assist in minor maintenance on machinery and equipment.
- Ability to lift and carry 50-pounds.
- Employee will be subject to emergency callouts as needed.

The above statements are not a complete list of all responsibilities, duties, and skills held or performed by employees in the job. Employee may perform other related duties as assigned.

Required knowledge, skills, and abilities

- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Good math skills.
- Ability to work without direct supervision.
- Ability to attend and understand technical courses.
- Ability to assume responsibility for complete operations of treatment process.
- Ability to make sound independent decisions.

Conditions of Employment

- Must pass a SCBA physical and fit test prior to employment.
- Ability to obtain Illinois EPA water license. KWD is willing to train unlicensed individuals.

Salary/Benefits: \$22.35 - 28.35 per hour depending on license. Paid Vacation, health insurance, retirement, sick leave, union representation and tuition reimbursement.
