- Not for Profits
- Indian tribes
- Population of 10,000 or less WW
- Population of 50,000 Guarantees



# Pre-Development and Planning Grants (PPG)

#### Eligibility

- Most State and Local governments (Public Bodies), Not for Profit Organizations and Federallyrecognized Tribes.
- Rural service areas less than 10,000
- MHI of the service area must be less than 80% of statewide non-metro and/or below poverty level.
- Pay costs associated with developing an application for a proposed water or wastewater project:
  - Preliminary Engineering Report
  - Environmental Report
  - Costs incurred prior to grant closing will not be considered eligible for PPG.
- The proposed project must be for eligible loan and grant purposes.
- Applicants must show they do not have resources to pay predevelopment expenses on their own.
- Grants limited to \$30,000 or 75% of the project cost, whichever is less.

# SEARCH GRANT

Special Evaluation Assistance for Rural Communities and House holds Grant

# Eligibility

 Most State and Local governments (Public Bodies), Not for Profit Organizations and Federally-recognized Tribes.

#### Rural and financially distressed service area:

- areas with populations of 2,500 or fewer, according to the most recent U.S. Census data
- Have median household incomes either below the poverty line or less than 80 percent of the statewide, nonmetropolitan median household income using 2020 2021 American Community Survey data.

#### Grant funds can be used to pay for eligible predevelopment planning costs and activities, including:

- Feasibility studies to support applications for funding water or waste disposal projects
- · Preliminary design and engineering analysis
- Technical assistance to develop applications for financial assistance

# SEARCH GRANT Special Evaluation Assistance for Rural Communities and House holds Grant

## Are there additional requirements?

Yes, Predevelopment planning costs must be related to a proposed project that:

- Builds, enlarges, extends, or improves rural water, wastewater, solid waste, or storm water disposal facilities.
- Builds or relocates public or private buildings, roads, bridges, fences, or utilities, or makes other improvements necessary for the successful operation or protection of facilities.

# Emergency Community Water Assistance Grants (ECWAG)

#### Eligibility

- Most State and Local governments (Public Bodies), Not for Profit Organizations and Federally-recognized Tribes
- Rural service areas 10,000 or less.
- Helps eligible communities prepare or recover from an emergency that threatens the availability of safe, reliable drinking water.
- Events included, but not limited to: Drought or flood, earthquake, tornado or hurricane, disease outbreak, chemical spill leak or seepage.
- Funds can be used to make repairs to water lines not to exceed \$150,000. If the water source has been negatively impacted, grants up to \$1,000,000 may be obtained.
- Simplified Engineering and Environmental Reporting Requirements.



# Water & Waste Programs

- Funds can be used for new construction, improvements, renovations, replacements, extensions, engineering and legal fees, land, equipment, other soft costs, etc.
- Typical projects: Water or sewer main replacement, new treatment plants, storage tanks, extensions to serve additional users, regional water supplies, other.
- Funding could range from less than \$100,000 to millions.
- Grant funds may be available in order to keep user rates reasonable.
- Can partner with other funding sources.



# FY 2024

- Applications accepted year around for core programs
  - > Able to fund applications typically same year received. Looking for apps
  - > Funded over \$240 M in projects in last 3 years (WEP).
  - Funded \$34M this year so far
  - Loan/Grant decisions made project by project based on qualifications/user rates/need/available funding. This year grant funding was limited.
- Low Fixed Interest Rates 6/1/24 9/3/24, Up to 40 yr Terms
  > WW Loans (P) 2.375% (I) 3.250% (M) 4.000%
- Online application process available RD Apply.
- Can leverage our funds with almost any other private/state/fed sources
